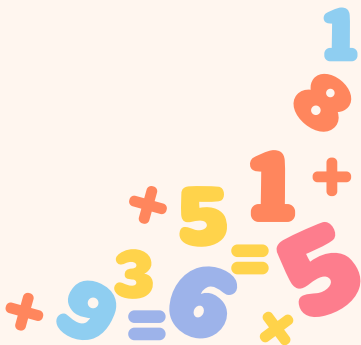


Field Trips
