KIK/Primary Sharing experience

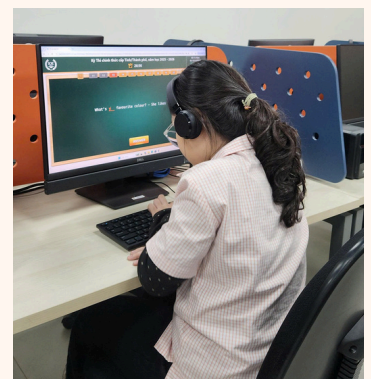
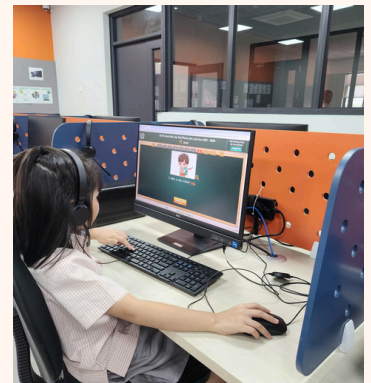

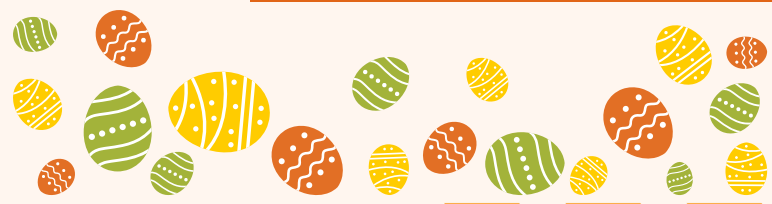




Easter Egg Hunt

Field Trips



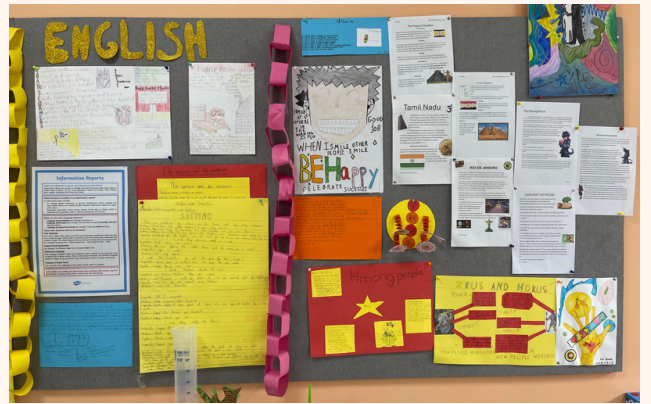

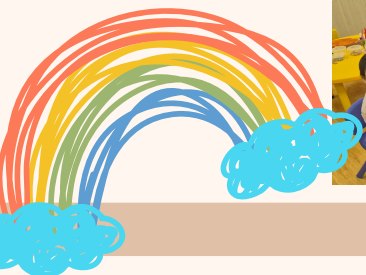
